Abstract:

The department of Textile Technologies was established in May 2014 in Saxony's Manchester. Their focus is on developing technical textiles for applications such as fibre composites for textile reinforced concrete and metallic compounds. They work on process development, product development, and modifications of textile machinery. The department has partnerships with several institutions, including the Endowed Chair for Technical Textiles/Textile Machine Elements, the Endowed Chair for Textile Plastic Composites and Hybrid Compounds, the Cetex Institute for Textile and Processing Machines, the Saxony Textile Research Institute, the Textile Research Institute Thuringia-Vogtland, and the University of Applied Science Zwickau - Reichenbach.

Biography:



Prof. Holger Cebulla has had a diverse career within the textile industry and academia. He founded and co-organized the Sustainable Textile School Chemnitz in 2017. Prof. Holger Cebulla has been a professor of Textile Technologies at Chemnitz University of Technology since 2014 and served in several leading positions within the Division Textile and as a member of the management at Rieter AG from 2007 to 2014. He received his PhD in 2004 from Dresden University of Technology, where he had also worked as a research associate from 1998 to 2004.
