What is the Green Summer School?

It is an interdisciplinary, international, and multicultural summer school in Aveiro (Portugal) where you will take part in workshops, seminars, and project on sustainable textiles. Studying, exploring, and designing will be merged with active and creative teamwork.

The topics of the projects will be focused on sustainable design and process in textiles.

The summer school takes place from 4 September to 8 September 2023.
