THE IMPORTANCE OF ECO-LABEL FOR EXPORT OF THE TEXTILE PRODUCTS

Abstract:

The Academy of Professional Studies South Serbia, as an independent higher education institution with its study programs, student opportunity to do professional practice in the country and abroad, as well as the possibilities of student exchange to the Department of Technological and Artistic Professional Studies in Leskovac will be presented.

In the lecture the importance of the eco-label system for export from Serbia to the European Union will be presented, as a result of the increasing environmental and health awareness of the EU countries. For this purpose, the eco-label system has been implemented or must be implemented in Serbia, covering a large number of groups of textile products. Therefore, the collection, processing and analysis of labels with eco-labels found on textile products in Leskovac was researched. The aim of the research was to give an overview of all the labels of ecological suitability of textile products presented in the most frequented textile stores, to analyze the market of textile products and the presence of eco-labels on both imported products and products of domestic companies that export to foreign markets or are present on the local market. It was found that the most frequently used eco-label on textile articles researched was one of OEKO-TEX, while the least frequent were the TÜV Rheinland and GS eco-labels. It was found that one product did not have any eco-label, while most textile articles could be found simultaneously with several different eco-labels.

Biography:



Suzana Đorđević, PhD, was born in 1971 in Leskovac, Serbia. She defended her doctoral thesis entitled "Synthesis of starch-based derivatives and their application in yarn starching processes" in 2014 at the Faculty of Technology in Leskovac. She is currently employed at the Academy of Professional Studies in Southern Serbia, Department of Technological and Artistic Professional Studies in Leskovac, as a professor. She gained a good part of her work experience in the textile industry, where she worked for 8 years, in the textile factory for the production of woolen fabrics Leteks in Leskovac. So far, she has published a total of 92

scientific papers in international and national journals and proceedings from meetings of international and national significance. The topics of scientific papers refer to chemical and mechanical processing of textile materials and products. She has participated in one national and two international project, so far. She is married and has two sons.
